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The 2024 Nation's Report Card shows that we have complex challenges to solve in regard to student achievement: the percentage of eighth-graders' reading below <u>NAEP Basic</u> was the largest in the assessment's history, and the percentage of fourth-graders who scored below <u>NAEP Basic</u> was the largest in 20 years.

As an intervention that outperforms other interventions, high-dosage tutoring should be provided to every student who needs it during the school day. Making it affordable and accessible is no easy task. This week, we joined @ProvenTutoring, @Accelerate, and our colleagues – researchers, practitioners, and policymakers – at @Hopkins Bloomberg Center in exploring ways we can scale and sustain this intervention. #StateofHDT2025

Tutoring has tremendous potential for improving student achievement. In a 2024 <u>study</u> of a district tutoring program operating at scale, @Matthew Kraft and colleagues conclude, "the long-term future of individualized instruction in public education depends critically on the ability of districts to successfully deliver tutoring as part of their regular programming and to sustain the funding and staff necessary to do so."
